

## Swamp Wallaby (*Wallabia bicolor*)

**This is our largest native animal at the Maroochy Wetlands Sanctuary, standing to 850 mm. Although common along the whole east coast of Australia, they are not seen regularly. Near the river, the Salt-water Couch provides a good source of food, and they leave their cover in thicker vegetation after sunset to graze throughout the night. During the day, they browse on the foliage of shrubs and ferns. Their typical footprints may occasionally be seen in softer mud.**
